Itinerary

(B)(L)(D) 🗝 Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Fri 06 Sep / Auckland – Vancouver

We fly to Vancouver and overnight in this beautiful city.

Sat 07 Sep / Vancouver

Sightseeing tour including Stanley Park, Capilano Suspension Bridge, Yaletown, Chinatown and Granville Island Market for leisure time to explore the Market on your own. Welcome dinner this evening (B)(D)

Sun 08 Sep / Vancouver

Day at leisure. There is so much to do in this waterfront city. Shopping and restaurants abound! Perhaps watch the floatplanes taking off from the harbour whilst enjoying a bite to eat. (B)

Mon 09 Sep / Vancouver - Kamloops (Rocky Mountaineer)

Board the Rocky Mountaineer for your 'First Passage to the West' railtour. Pass through the fertile fields of the Fraser Valley and view the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains before entering the Fraser Canyon. You'll see the thundering waters of Hells' Gate and follow the Thompson River to historic Kamloops. Overnight at a hotel in Kamloops. (B)(L)

Tue 10 Sep / Kamloops – Banff (Rocky Mountaineer)

Continue east through the vast ranchlands of the South Thompson River, past Craigellachie, and enter Rogers Pass, with its tunnels, snowsheds and glistening glaciers. Climb the spiral tunnels and over the Continental Divide to Banff. (B)(L)

Wed 11 Sep / Banff

Morning sightseeing tour of Banff including Cave & Basin, Bow Valley and the Falls, Surprise Corner, the Hoodoos and Gondola ride up Sulphur Mountain for a breathtaking view. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Thu 12 Sep / Banff - Lake Louise

A short drive through the Valley of the Ten Peaks and turquoise shimmering Moraine Lake before arriving at the famous Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. Enjoy your lake view room. (B)(D)

Fri 13 Sep / Lake Louise – Jasper

Drive to Jasper via the Icefields Parkway. Enjoy a Ice Explorer ride on Athabasca Glacier. (B)(D)

Sat 14 Sep / Jasper (VIA Rail)

Enjoy a three hour wildlife discovery tour. Afternoon at leisure before an evening departure aboard VIA Rail's 'The Canadian' for your 3 day rail journey across Canada. Private bedrooms are included. (B)(D)

Sun 15 Sep / VIA Rail (B)(L)(D)

Tue 17 Sep / Arrive Toronto
