

Getting High in the Kimberley





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Located in Australia's far North West corner lies a vast landscape brimming with an abundance of unbelievable natural attractions that very few have experienced.

Rugged and remote this is outback at its best, a photographer's dream with picture perfect settings, vibrant sunsets, unspoilt beaches, incredible wildlife, ancient rock art and an alluring charm spread far and wide. Your journey will take you on an unforgettable adventure that incorporates the Kimberley's most famous landmarks, a 'best of' collection that includes the town of Kununurra, the World Heritage listed Purnululu National Park and its Bungle Bungle range, Emma Gorge, the impressive waterfalls of the Mitchell Falls, Aboriginal rock art and fishing on the spectacular Kimberley Coast, pearl farming on the Dampier Peninsula, the vibrant red cliffs and white sand of Cape Leveque, finishing up in the exotic pearling town of Broome.



Itinerary

Day One: Kununurra

On arrival in Kununurra, meet up with the group late afternoon and enjoy drinks and dinner at the Pinctada Kimberley Grande.

Overnight: *Pinctada Kimberley Grande*

Meals: **D**

Day Two: Kununurra, Lake Argyle & the Ord River

Leisurely start before exploring the stunning waters of the Ord River and Lake Argyle. Spot native wildlife and an array of birdlife along the way. Cruise through spectacular gorge country, tributary creek systems and wetlands and visit historic Durack homestead. Dinner tonight is at the Pumphouse Restaurant & Bar

Overnight: *Pinctada Kimberley Grande*

Meals: **B.D.**

Day Three: Purnululu National Park & Bungle Bungle Range

Fly over Lake Argyle landing at Purnululu National Park; wander through the striped beehive domes of the Bungle Bungle range, into Cathedral Gorge amphitheatre.

Overnight: *Ensuite Cabins, East Kimberley Bush Camp*

Meals: **B.L.D.**

Day Four: Bungle Bungle, Echidna Gorge & Emma Gorge

Further explore the Bungle Bungle range including the impressive Echidna Chasm. After lunch fly to El Questro Emma Gorge Resort. Walk to the gorge, before sunset drinks followed by dinner.

Overnight: *Tented Cabins, El Questro Emma Gorge Resort*

Meals: **B.L.D.**

Day Five: Emma Gorge

Morning bush tour and a swim at Zebedee Springs before a steak and barramundi lunch. Explosion Gorge 4WD adventure in the afternoon returning as the sun sets.

Overnight: *Tented Cabins, El Questro Emma Gorge Resort*

Meals: **B.L.**

Day Six: Emma Gorge, Mitchell Falls & Admiralty Gulf

Early flight to Mitchell Plateau, connecting with a helicopter which will drop you at the departure point for the Mitchell Falls walk. Leave the falls by helicopter, landing at a remote wilderness escape with a rustic charm nestled inside Admiralty Gulf, here fabulous scenery and gourmet food await. You will be served lunch on arrival before an afternoon activity.

Overnight: *Guest Gazebo, Kimberley Coastal Camp*



Day Seven: Kimberley Coastal Camp, Admiralty Gulf

Spend time trolling the waters for the not so elusive catch, before the expert guides lead you to the incredible rock art sites; enjoy bushwalking spotting an impressive display of bird and wild life along the way. This place is remote, but oh so magical!

Overnight: *Guest Gazebo, Kimberley Coastal Camp*

Day Eight: Kimberley Coast & the Dampier Peninsula

Early rise, depart by helicopter to Mitchell Plateau to board your charter flight to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm. Learn the history of pearling and see a pearl farm in operation including a chance to purchase your own pearls. Continue your flight to Cape Leveque where you'll stay for next two nights.

Overnight: *Safari Tent, Kooljaman at Cape Leveque* Meals: **B.L.D.**

Day Nine: Cape Leveque, Dampier Peninsula

It's an idyllic setting and the day is yours with a diverse range of activities on offer, beaches and estuaries to explore, snorkelling or relaxing. If you're feeling adventurous, let the local guides teach you mud crabbing or join a fishing charter (additional fees apply for fishing & mud crabbing).

Overnight: *Safari Tent, Kooljaman at Cape Leveque* Meals: **B.**

Day Ten: Cape Leveque & Broome

Farewell Cape Leveque and experience travelling on red dirt, outback roads as you travel to Broome stopping off at an Aboriginal community on the way. Arrive at the spectacular pearling town of Broome as the sun sets over Cable Beach and camel trains line its shores.

Overnight: *Cable Beach Club & Resort** Meals: **B.**

Day Eleven: Broome

Hop on board your ½ day Broome Town Tour and discover the history of Pearling and the Asian influence that it brought to the town. Hear the stories of the early Pearl divers on the Pearl Luggers Tour. Taste boutique beers and savour lunch at a local brewery Matso's. Your afternoon is free to explore the town or take in a movie at Sun Pictures outdoor theatre.

Overnight: *Cable Beach Club & Resort** Meals: **B.L**

Day Twelve: Broome

A free morning, before enjoying hors d'oeuvres on a 3-hour afternoon sail aboard a Pearl Lugger. Tonight's the last night, and time to celebrate your journey, and enjoy a Thai Banquet at Thai Pearl.

Overnight: *Cable Beach Club & Resort** Meals: **B.D**


Day Thirteen: Onward Journey

After breakfast our Kimberley Journey concludes Meals: **B.**



Terms & Conditions

This tour has been arranged by Holland Clarke and Beatson Ltd, trading as Holland Clarke and Beatson Travel (HCB). HCB is a fully bonded member of the Travel Agents Association of New Zealand (TAANZ) and is a member of IATA (International Air Transport Association). Prices are "per person" in New Zealand Dollars based on Getting High in the Kimberley's Itinerary (commencing in Kununurra and finishing in Broome) and includes all charter flights and helicopter flights as mentioned in the Kimberley, sightseeing, entrance fees, permits, transfers, accommodation and meals as specified. Itinerary includes 12 nights accommodation. Airfares from New Zealand to Kununurra and return from Broome to New Zealand are not included. These are additional, as are any additional nights required pre/post or in getting to/from the start/end destination. Prices are for payment by internet banking, or cash, or personal or bank cheque and subject to availability at time of booking. Prices are based on current exchange rates as at 21 October 2012. Due to possible currency fluctuations and changes in service costs, prices are subject to variation at any time until full payment is received. Please note that for contractual reasons pricing cannot be itemised out.

Weight Restrictions
