



#### Chicago -USA

Chicago is recognised as one of the most passionate sporting destinations in the United States. After the success of the All Blacks first tour in 2014, the boys are back to face 2015 Six Nations champions Ireland at Soldier Field.

Irish fans will be out in force and will no doubt help add to a festival stadium atmosphere. The game is part of a special double header weekend that include Maori All Blacks vs USA Eagles at Toyota Park the night before. The extremes and contrasts of Chicago make it a fascinating place to visit. Chicago's downtown architecture is beautiful and the skyline is home to three of America's five tallest buildings, offering the most well travelled with visitor breath-taking views.

There is plenty to see and do. You can visit the Art Institute of Chicago – the second largest art museum in the US; Magnificent Mile – Chicago's largest shopping district; Millennium Park – an outdoor modern design gallery; and the Navy Pier – the city's most visited attraction.

# **STADIUMS**



#### Soldier Field Chicago

Home to the Chicago Bears, Soldier Field opened in 1924 and has the prestige of being the oldest stadium that is still used by an NFL Team. The All Blacks faced the USA Eagles in front of a sell-out crowd at this famous ground in 2014.

Soldier Field has also played host to major musical events including concerts by Pink Floyd, The Eagles, Madonna and The Rolling Stones.

#### Stadio Olympico Rome

Situated two and a half miles north of the Vatican City with the river Tiber running alongside it, the 82,000-capacity Olimpico is one of Italy's most revered sporting arenas.


The Stadium was built in 1928 and took centre stage in the 1960 Rome Olympics as the opening and closing ceremonies and athletics events were staged there.

Currently it is home to the capital's two major football teams - AS Roma and SS Lazio - who share the ground for their home league games in Serie A.

As the 80,000 spectators who watched Italy play New Zealand at the San Siro in 2009 showed, Italian rugby has an enthusiastic and very vocal following.



# **STADIUMS**



#### Stade de France France

Built for the 1998 football World Cup, the Stade de France took on a dual purpose almost immediately, first playing host to international rugby in February that year.

France welcomed cross-channel rivals England to the Parisian suburb of Saint Denis and won 24-17, with Philippe Bernat-Salles scoring the first try ever at the stadium. That summer the French football team wrote themselves into the history books at the Stade de France by lifting the World Cup for the first time with a 3-0 win over Brazil. The stadium played host to the rugby equivalent nine years later, in October 2007, with South Africa defeating England 15-6 to lift the Webb Ellis Trophy - making it the only stadium to have hosted a World Cup final in both sports.

With a capacity of 80,000 it is the sixth largest stadium in Europe, just behind Twickenham, and replaced Parc des Princes as the home of French rugby.

#### Aviva Stadium Ireland

Aviva Stadium, which boasts a 57,100 capacity, sits on the site of Irish rugby's former home Lansdowne Road, which was demolished for rebuilding in 2007.

The first international rugby fixture to be played at the Aviva Stadium was in November 2010 with Ireland welcoming South Africa for the first of four autumn games.

The Irish are passionate about their rugby and create arguably the finest stadium atmosphere in the game. Live rugby at Aviva is a moment to be cherished.
