



HONG KONG SEVENS 27-29 March 2015

The HSBC Sevens World Series, previously known as the IRB Sevens World Series, consists of nine tournaments held around the world between October and May. National Sevens teams compete for World Series points at each round, with winners in the Cup, Plate, Bowl and Shield crowned at each location. An overall HSBC Sevens World Series champion is crowned at the end of the season based on points. The 2012/13 World Series winners and reigning champions are New Zealand, who have won the Series 11 times in all and are also now the reigning Rugby World Cup Sevens champions, having won the title in Moscow in June 2013.
